As exemplified by websites like iTunesU, SlideShare, VideoLectures.net, and YouTube University channels, the expectation that a student, faculty, or guest lecturer will share the educational material taught in or created for a class is quickly becoming a common part of the educational experience. In this hour long workshop, two former SI grads and co-organizers of the University of Michigan Open, Michigan Open Educational Resources Team (<http://open.umich.edu/>, <http://michigan.educommons.net>), Pieter Kleymeer and Garin Fons, will guide participants on how to avoid copyright pitfalls as they create presentations, posters, and other educational content that can be shared and reused by students, educators, and self-learners worldwide. We will talk about where to search for openly licensed content, how to incorporate these and cite your educational material, and show you how to effectively license your own content using Creative Commons licenses.
