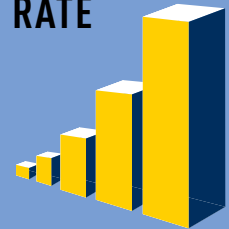
About this report

The University of Michigan School of Information (UMSI) Career Development Office surveys our graduates to identify their post-graduation plans and outcomes. This report summarizes UMSI first-destination outcomes from 2023 MHI graduates who completed the survey by the deadline or for whom a known outcome was reported in other ways. Of the 36 MHI students who graduated in 2023, 83% responded to the survey or reported their outcomes in other ways.



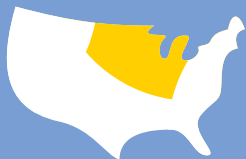

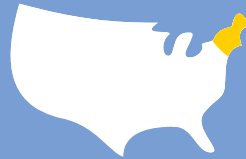

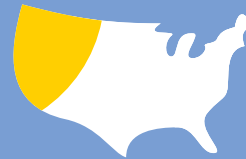

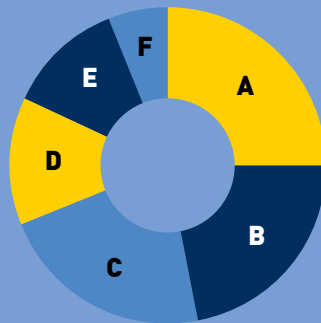
Of the graduates who responded to the survey question, 58% indicated they experienced an
