

UMSI Annual Fund - 364260

The UMSI Annual Fund is an unrestricted fund used at the discretion of the dean to be used where it is most needed and as opportunities arise. This fund has been used to support student scholarships, student organization events, faculty hiring activities, and other school-wide needs.

UMSI Student Emergency Fund - 335645

This fund aims to help meet the financial needs of UMSI students who encounter an emergency situation or one-time, unusual, or unforeseen expenses during their degree program.

Engaged Learning Funds

Al Carlson Internship Fund - 700543

Supports students who are participating in innovative internships that help move forward the information field.

Alternative Spring Break Gift Fund - 308817

ASB student participants at the School of Information are placed in non-profit, cultural, governmental, and K12 educational institutions in several cities for a week long service-oriented integrative learning experience.

Barbara Yaney Palmer Experience Internship Award Fund - 798671

Provides support for UMSI student internships.

Dr. Veronica Wilkerson Johnson Diversity Internship Award - 798898

Supports an annual internship award for UMSI students who might not otherwise be able to afford to accept career-building internship opportunities in major urban areas.

Emily Mobley Student Activities - 799674

This fund supports student activities at UMSI, such as internships, study abroad, service projects, and other engaged learning opportunities.

Exposition - 335161

Annual UMSI event where students exhibit projects to employers, peers, prospective students, faculty and the U-M community.

Field Entrepreneurship and Innovation Endowment Scholarship Fund - 796709

This fund provides need-based assistance for students to attend entrepreneurial events and to support initiatives and activities that enhance students' educational experiences.

Frost Open Access Endowed Fund - 700484

Used to support students in unpaid internships in open access repositories of data and/or publications; organizations that promote open access in scholarly communications, in an open access journal, or in open access technology.

Jason W. Blessing Family Endowment - 700673

This fund enables UMSI students to pursue summer internships and funds hands-on entrepreneurial focused class projects.

Joyce Karyl L. Winn Internship Fund - 333517

Supports internship awards within the School of Information.

Margo Crist Engaged Learning Fund - 700258

This endowed fund is used to support students participating in engaged learning programs and applied student projects at UMSI such as: Global Information Engagement Program (GIEP), Citizen Interaction Design (CID), internships, and study abroad.

SI Founders Fund - 316445

Supports Citizen Interaction Design: A partnership between select Michigan municipalities and the School of Information that aims to develop information tools designed to help citizens interact with their local government in new ways.

SI Horizon Fund - 797384

Provides support to UMSI students pursuing educational experiences that take place outside of the classroom that enhance their classroom learning.

Teresa Noel Urban Blaurock Student Research Fund - 701242

This fund supports graduate and undergraduate students engaging in research projects in partnership with UMSI researchers.

UMSI Engaged Learning Program Gifts - 329408

This expendable fund is used to support engaged learning programs and applied student projects at UMSI such as: Data Dive, Alternative Spring Break, internships, and study abroad.

UMSI Internship Undergrad Award Fund - 323870

Provides funding for students who participate in unpaid summer internships.

Annual UMSI event where students exhibit projects to employers, peers, prospective students, faculty and the U-M community.

This fund supports the BSI program by bringing innovators and entrepreneurs to the school to engage with current and former students.

Hoffman Family Career Innovations Endowed Fund - 701515

This fund is used to sustain the exploration and implementation of new career programs by supporting UMSI staff time to create, experiment, implement, and assess programming that allows students to explore career paths in the information fields.

Jeffrey King Mackie-Mason Fund - 796714

SI Employer/Career Services - 312974

This fund supports employer events and career development services including UMSI Career Fair, employer site visits (Career Insider), and on-campus recruiting.

UMSI Online Student Wellness and Recreation Fund - 337028

This fund supports the wellness and mental health needs of UMSI students.

UMSI PhD & Staff Home Office Fund - 336995

This fund supports remote working needs of PhD students and staff members.

William Warner Bishop Lectureship - 790960

This fund supports the William Warner Bishop Lectureship series on librarianship.
