

University of Michigan School of Information graduates obtain innovative, diverse, professional jobs in a wide range of work settings and positions, from public libraries, health systems and nonprofits to the largest consulting and tech companies in the world. The nature of the positions ranges from entry-level to senior level, management and advanced positions. As industries and hiring started to open up more this year, UMSI graduates found jobs across industries and levels of roles. This report summarizes UMSI first-destination outcomes from 2021 graduates who completed the survey by the deadline or for whom a known outcome was reported in other ways.
