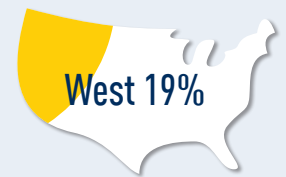
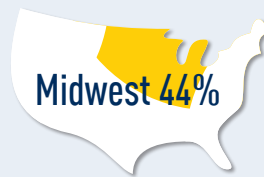

While many grads are working in hybrid or remote work locations, the top regions for job acceptance included Midwest (44%), Northeast (22%) and West (19%).

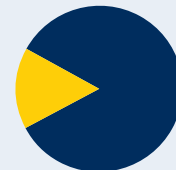
