

University of Michigan School of Information Fee Waiver Eligibility Requirements and Form

If Applying for a Need-based Fee Waiver you must be:

A U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident of the United States (with a registration number).

AND

An Undergraduate College Senior receiving financial aid at an institution in the U.S., Puerto Rico, or U.S. territory.

AND

Status as a dependent with a parental contribution of not more than \$900 and no personal contribution during the senior year.

OR

Status as self-supporting with a personal contribution of not more than \$1,200 during the senior year and received no parental funds.

 - If denied, payment by credit card is required to submit the online application.
- **Need-based Fee Waiver Applicants:**
 - Submit the Fee Waiver form to your Undergraduate Financial Aid Office.
 - Your Financial Aid Office completes the bottom section of the form and faxes or emails the form to the School of Information for review.
- **Experience, Non-Candidate for Degree, or Readmit Fee Waiver Applicants:**
 - **If you are a member of one of the above listed organizations, please submit proof of eligibility with your fee waiver application.** This could be a letter of verification of participation. If you are a Readmit or Non-Candidate for Degree applicant, please submit a letter stating this. You will also be required to upload the proof of eligibility with your online application
- **Merit – Based Fee Waiver Applicants**
 - Please include the email which states that you received a merit-based fee waiver along with your form.
